Police Officer

The Colerain Police Department will conduct a written examination for Police Officer on May 14, 2016 at 9am to fill several part-time police officer positions with a strong potential for fulltime status in the future. Detailed information regarding the test will be provided in advance of test date. Candidates must have a valid driver’s license, and be 21 years of age or older, have a High School diploma or equivalent. Duties include maintaining law and order, investigating traffic and criminal offenses, and protecting life and property within Colerain Township. Candidates must successfully complete the following tests: written, physical fitness, oral interview, CVSA, background check, psychological screening, and medical with drug screen. The written test will be waived for experienced police officers meeting certain criteria. A \$30 non-refundable administrative fee is required at time of application. It is anticipated the testing process will be completed prior to August 1, 2016.

Candidates may register for the test by submitting a completed application to the Colerain Police Department, 4200 Springdale Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45251, 24 hours a day, Monday – Friday. Applications and testing process information are available at the Police Department during those same hours. Please visit our website at www.colerainpolice.org and click on the “Recruiting” link from the homepage to access information related to the duties and responsibilities of a police officer, hiring process fitness testing standards, and “What it takes to become a Colerain Police Officer”. Applications must be returned by 11:59pm on May 9, 2016. All reasonable requests for ADA assistance in taking the test must be submitted in writing at time of application.
