


MAIN STREET TRAIL



3.0 miles trail through Northbrook and Peach Grove/Daleview Community Character Areas.




Destinations along the trail include Clippard and Colerain Park, the Colerain Admin Building & Stone Creek Towne Center.

The **Main Street Trail** is the first essential trail system which comprises of our Colerain Community Connector network. The Main Street Trail is a 3.0-mile journey which starts at our beautiful Clippard Park and ends at Colerain High School. Other passerby destinations include Stone Creek Towne Center, Colerain Park, and the Colerain Township Administrative Complex. The cool thing about this trail is that it is already existing due to the sidewalks and current infrastructure. We just need to highlight all the walkable areas within our township. This will be the trailblazer of our new trail network. Prioritizing connectivity other than through car transportation is vital in a thriving and progressive community.
