
## **COLERAIN TOWNSHIP PREPARATIONS FOR COVID-19**

While recent events may be preempting regular updates concerning the COVID-19 pandemic, we urge our Colerain Community to continue prevention practices that have gotten us where we are now. Relatively speaking, our Colerain Community has done well compared to many other areas of the state and country. We have definitely seen sickness and even deaths in Colerain, but we must keep things in perspective and understand the statistics being presented. Our regional COVID-19 positive numbers have risen, but this is more specifically due to the increased availability of testing. We would expect to see that number increase. The real gauge to use at this time is the number of hospitalizations and deaths – as this number gives us a clearer idea of the catastrophic nature of the disease. These numbers continue to remain flattened with NO significant daily increases over the last several weeks.

The Colerain Township Board of Trustees has continued the Emergency Declaration for the Township and will readdress as needed to determine a date to remove it.

- No visitors policies continue
- Employees are medically screened each shift

- Call **911** if you have **SEVERE**
  - Cough
  - Fever
  - Shortness of Breath

## COMMUNITY & FAITH

- Online church services
- No gatherings over 10 people

## COLERAIN TOWNSHIP STAFF & FACILITIES

- Colerain personnel continue to work remotely when possible following Governor Dewine’s plea to do so “When humanly possible”
- All employees are screened prior to shifts
  - FD screenings twice per 24 hr. shift
- Leadership team continues to meet daily for updates and continued planning
