



Crime Report 2015-Present

Skyline Acres Neighborhood



Skyline Acres is situated in the southeast portion of Colerain Township bordering Springfield Township. Skyline Acres is spread over approximately 0.7 square miles and is home to approximately 1,717 residents.

Both the Northwest Local and Mount Healthy School Districts serve the children of Skyline Acres.

Perceptions

- It is perceived (incorrectly), even by some who are able to access the data, that the Skyline Acres community is crime-ridden and violent. The truth is, that could not be further from the truth.
- Skyline Acres is a quiet, family-oriented neighborhood that sees very little crime. The properties are well-maintained and demonstrate a pride in ownership.
- The Colerain Police Department conducted a 100% door-to-door canvass in 2016 to talk about issues impacting this great neighborhood. Most of the issues involved being labeled as “high crime” and not being able to have access to services like the newspaper and pizza deliveries.

Reality

- There has been an almost imperceptible level of crime for years .
- Skyline Acres is a quiet, family-oriented neighborhood that sees very little crime. Since January 1, 2015:

Reality

- Skyline Acres is 1.59% of the housing, 2.94% of the population and 1.62% of the land in Colerain yet only contributes .52% of the crime.
- Skyline Acres is a safe, clean and friendly neighborhood:
- There have been 2 violent crimes reported in Skyline Acres in the past 39 months.
- As the Chief of Police, I wish the entire Township reflected the same activity levels as Skyline Acres.
