




Homicide	Intentionally causing the death of another person without extreme provocation or legal justification or (2) causing the death of another while committing or attempting to commit another crime.
Rape	Forced sexual intercourse including both psychological coercion and physical force. Forced sexual intercourse means vaginal, anal, or oral penetration by the offender(s).
Robbery	Completed or attempted theft, directly from a person, of property or cash by force or threat of force, with or without a weapon, and with or without injury.
Aggravated Assault	An attack or attempted attack with a weapon, regardless of whether an injury occurred, and an attack without a weapon when serious injury results.
Burglary	Unlawful or forcible entry or attempted entry of a residence.
Breaking and Entering	Unlawful entry into an unoccupied structure (garage, shed) where there is no reasonable expectation that someone lives in that structure.
Theft	The unlawful taking of property other than a motor vehicle from the possession of another, by stealth, without force or deceit.
Auto Theft	Stealing or unauthorized taking of a motor vehicle, including attempted thefts.
